Performance Dashboard

The Performance Dashboard is a way to keep track of all user activity in a Course. All users enrolled in the Course are listed, with the important information about that user's progress and activity in the Course.

View the Performance Dashboard

- To view the Performance Dashboard of a Course, first make sure you are in the course you would like to work in and that you have the edit mode set to ON
- Next in the Evaluation section of the Control Panel, select Performance Dashboard.

The Performance Dashboard page displays the following information for each Course User:

- Last Name
- First Name
- Username
- ➢ Role
- Last Course Access
- Days since Last Course Access
- Review Status
- Adaptive Release
- Discussion Board
- Early Warning System
- View Grades
- To know what any Course User has reviewed:
 - Select the User in question and either select their value in the Review Status Column to see a list of Content Items they have viewed.
- To know what Discussion Board Forums any Course User has participated in:
 - Select the User in question and select their value in the Discussion Board Column. Once in the Discussion Board: User Page, you can see what Forums they have participated in, how many posts in each Forum, Date of Last Post, Average/Minimum/Maximum Post Lengths, Average Post Position and Grade.

NOTE: When you view the Performance Dashboard – it may open up wide and you may lose the navigation along the left hand side of you course. To close the "window shade" simply click the gray arrow inside a white box that is located on the left.
